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## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. Eligible Wines

Any wine can be entered provided it meets the bottling and labelling requirement (see condition 2 and 9), and is produced in South Africa.

### 2. Minimum production requirements and bottling

- No minimum production requirement exists.
- Tank or barrel samples are not eligible for entry. Any award made will apply only to wines bottled under the nominated batch number.
- The bottles entered must have full etiquette.

### 3. Cases available for purchase by Winemakers' Choice:

- Winemakers' Choice will want to purchase the Diamond Award winning wines from the farm at Trade Price throughout the year after the awards, and request that an allocation is made for this purpose.

### 4. Entry Fees for 2010

The entry fee for the 2010 competition is **R640.00 (VAT Inclusive) per entry**. Entrants should deposit the amount into the following account:

### 5. Entry Forms and Entry Fees Deadline

Entries will be accepted from **1 April 2010 until 17h00 on Friday, 23 July 2010**. **All fees are to be paid prior to entry and proof of payment supplied via email or fax**. Regrettably no late entries can be accepted.

### 6. Separate Entry Forms

If an entrant wishes to enter more than one label, a separate entry form is required for each label.

### 7. Judging Samples

- Entrants are required to deliver **6 x 750ml bottles per entry**, to the address below, between **1 June 2010 until 17h00 on Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2010**:

- **Please mark clearly on the case, the category of each wine entered.**
- Entrants are encouraged to deliver their products as early as possible to allow for timely processing.

**8. Awards and Recognition of the show's finest entrants**

- Any wine entered will be eligible to win the Winemakers' Choice Diamond Award and will have the rights to display the Diamond Award sticker on the winning wine.
- Approximately the top ten percent of entries will receive the award and the judges hold the right to award more or less than ten percent if deemed necessary.
- The top red and white wine will receive the Winemakers' Choice Trophy Red Award and the Winemakers' Choice Trophy White Award respectively. The trophy winning wines will be selected from the Winemakers' Choice Diamond Award winning wines and will be granted the honour of receiving both awards.
- The winemakers of the Trophy Red and Trophy White, will be deemed the Winemakers' Choice Diamond Winemakers of the Year and will each receive a R25 000 prize.
- The best producer, the farm with the most Diamond Awards, will be deemed the Winemakers' Choice WineWare Best Producer, and will receive a Wine Tracking System valued at R40 000 from WineWare Consulting. This Wine Tracking system is an invaluable tool for monitoring and controlling the information and process of winemaking, either in the cellar or off-site.
- The Diamond Award stickers will be available for purchase from the organisers after the results are released. Only Winemakers' Choice Diamond Award winners will be eligible to use such stickers on the specific wine entered (i.e. carrying the same batch and lot number as the entered certification).
- Legal action will be taken against people/persons who use the Winemakers' Choice Diamond Award sticker unlawfully.
- The winner of the Winemakers' Choice SurePure Low Sulphur Award will receive a R25 000 prize and an additional sticker for their bottles.

**9. Inspection-Verification and Analyses of Stock**

- To ensure that a Diamond or Trophy winning wine is the same wine available for purchase under that label, the entrant agrees to Winemakers' Choice having the stock inspected by VINLAB.
- On any such inspection, the entrant agrees to the organiser removing two bottles of the entered wine's stock for the purpose of analysis and a comparison with one of the judging samples received from the entrant. If the judging samples are not considered, by VINLAB, to be the same wine as the sample from your stock, the entry will be disqualified and any award will be withdrawn. In such cases, the organiser reserves the right for further remedies. No refunds will be granted in this case.

**10. Disqualification**

The judges' decision is final. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions; will at the discretion of the organisers, result in the disqualification of the offending party.
